1. Solar power generation unit

The institute has installed (In April 2017) a Solar power generation unit with a maximum power output of 70KW which also full fills the power requirements. The total power generated by the solar power unit for the year 2022-23 (From July 22 to June 23) is 78470 units.



2. Biogas Plant

The institute has also installed a biogas plant which supplies biogas to the canteen. The same is also used along with the conventional LPG cylinders.



3. Wheeling to the Grid

The excess (surplus) solar energy generated by rooftop solar modules are exported to the grid of electricity distribution utility through net metering and direct saving in electricity bills are availed from electricity distribution utility on monthly basis.

No Party shall be considered in breach of this Contract to the extent that its performance of such obligations is delayed or prevented by reasons of any unforeseeable or unavoidable circumstance which is not under the control of such non-performing Party, including without limitation change in law, fire, flood, hurricanes, earthquake or similar natural disasters, riot, war, terrorism, labor strikes, excluding such labor strikes which solely affect a Party's workforce that is directly or indirectly employed by the Party in the performance of this Contract. It is understood that the Party affected by the force majeure event will use commercially reasonable efforts to minimize the impact of such event. In case event of force majeure lasts longer than 6 months, either Party may terminate said Contract by giving 30 days prior written notice to other Party.

16. No Other Warranties/Guaranties:

Synerge Overseas Pte Ltd disclaim all warranties / guaranties either expressed or implied (including, but not limited to implied warranty / guaranty, merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose), other than what is expressly stated in this contract/proposal.

17. Indemnity Clause:

The Parties agrees to indemnify and hold harmless to each other, its employees, officers and agents from and against any claim, loss, liability or cost of any person,

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firm or corporation, including without limitation, reasonable legal fees, arising directly or indirectly out of any breach of warranty, representation or undertaking made by the Parties in this Contract, provided that Parties shall inform immediately to other party of any such event. In the event of any claim, Parties will promptly adjust, settle, defend or otherwise dispose of such claim at its sole cost.

18. Limited Liability:

Liability of the Synerge Overseas Pte Ltd pursuant to this Contract shall be limited to the actual payment received under this Contract only for the first year. Synerge Overseas Pte Ltd shall not be liable to the Customer for any indirect and consequential damages, loss of profit, loss of use or any punitive damages.

19. Exclusions:

- Synerge Overseas Pte Ltd shall not be responsible or liable for obtaining the permits to erect or install any components like permits from CEIG, CEA, Electricity Board, Environmental Clearances, Local bodies, architects and any such approval plus clearances from any government or local utilities required to install and commission the photo-voltaic generation plant.
- <u>Foundation and reinforcement to the existing roof.</u> Roof to be provided to us free of cost.
- Space for Inverter nearest point of SPV installation.
- Any civil work beyond the defined scope of proposal submitted.

20. MNRE Clarification:

The Ministry will not guarantee for Subsidy for each and every solar installation. The channel partners are suggested to work out their own plans like to participating in tenders and to promote solar installation without subsidy by availing AD benefits. Ministry will call for proposals from channel partners for a limited quantity whenever funds are available. 21. Jurisdiction:

Jurisdiction shall be Pune. The courts in Pune shall have exclusive jurisdiction on this matter.
