

**Registration Process:** Candidates are required to follow the schedule for registration for KMAT 2026. The registration process is entirely online and straightforward, taking only a few minutes to complete.

**Admit Card:** The KMAT 2026 Admit Card will be issued online. Candidates must download the Admit Card and carefully follow the instructions provided on it.

**Eligibility:** MBA/MCA colleges in Bangalore and other parts of Karnataka, with a reasonable fee structure, will consider KMAT 2026 scores as part of their admission criteria. This applies to both All India Candidates and Karnataka Domicile candidates for admission to their flagship MBA/PGDM/MCA programs in 2026.

**Exam Conducted by KPPGCA:** Karnataka Management Aptitude Test (KMAT) 2026 is organized by the Karnataka Private Post Graduate Colleges Association (KPPGCA). It facilitates admission to over 189 AICTE approved and university-affiliated Management Institutes in Bangalore and Karnataka.

**All India Exam:** KMAT 2026 is an All India examination, taking place in more than 10 cities across Bangalore, Karnataka, and the entire country. It is open to candidates from all regions of India and abroad.

**Equal Opportunity:** KPPGCA believes in providing a level playing field for all test-takers. KMAT 2026 will be a Home Based Online Remote Proctored Test with a duration of 2 hours. The aim is to ensure a single testing session with the same difficulty level, eliminating any discrimination among candidates.

## KMAT Karnataka 2026 Application Form

Here are some important instructions to be followed while filling KMAT Karnataka Application Form 2026:

- Application form for KMAT Karnataka 2026 will be available via **online mode**.
- Online registration for Session-I will begin in **fourth week of June 2026**.
- Applicants are requested to meet the eligibility criteria before completing the application form.
- Students must ensure to provide all required details like **educational background, personal and address details**.
- All necessary documents, such as **photographs and signatures** must be uploaded in correct format.
- Candidates must fill in accurate information, as no corrections will be allowed after submission.
- Eligible students must complete and submit their application form for Session-I before **third week of September 2026**.
- Applicants must remember to print a copy of the completed application for future reference.

### Application Fee:

- KMAT Karnataka 2026 registration fee will be Rs.850/- for all categories.
- Payment of application fee will be made only through **online mode**.
- Debit card, credit card and net banking will be the available payment gateways.
- Once transferred, application fee will **not be refunded**.

## How to Apply for KMAT Karnataka 2026

Here, students can check the steps by step guide to apply for KMAT Karnataka 2026:

- **Step-1:** Go through the KMAT Karnataka website link (*link will be given above*).
- **Step-2:** Press on the "New registration" tab for fresh registration.
- **Step-3:** Enter registration details like name, email ID & mobile number.
- **Step-4:** Click on submit button and generate login credentials.
- **Step-5:** Now, login to the portal and fill in application details like personal, qualification and address details.
- **Step-6:** Also upload scanned documents like photograph & signature in specified format.
- **Step-7:** Deposit the application fee using the available payment method.
- **Step-8:** At last, take a printout of it for future correspondence.

# KMAT Karnataka 2026 Eligibility Criteria

Applying candidates must fulfill the given KMAT Karnataka Eligibility Criteria 2026:

- **Qualification:** Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree of at least 3 years or a master's degree in any field from an accredited university or institution.
- **Marks:** Candidates should have a minimum of 50% in aggregate marks in their qualifying degree (45% for reserved categories).
- **Subjects:** Aspirants must have passed their qualifying exam with mathematics as compulsory subject to apply for MCA course.
- **Appearing:** Students in their final year of qualifying degree programs will also be eligible to apply.

## KMAT Karnataka 2026 Exam Pattern

To know the KMAT Karnataka Exam Pattern 2026, go through the below section:

- **Exam Mode:** KMAT 2026 will be a Remote Proctored Internet-Based Test.
- **Duration:** Applicants will be given 2 hours to complete the exam.
- **Type of Questions:** Only Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) will be asked in exam.
- **Total Questions:** Question Paper will carry 120 questions (40 questions in each section).
- **Marking Scheme:** One mark will be awarded for each correct response and no deduction will be done for incorrect answers.

## KMAT Karnataka 2026 Syllabus

KMAT Karnataka Syllabus 2026 will be designed to assess candidates knowledge across three key section including:

- **Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension (VARC):** Reading comprehension, antonyms, grammar, synonyms, vocabulary and sentence completion.
- **Quantitative Ability (QA):** Arithmetic, algebra, statistics, trigonometry, geometry and modern mathematics.
- **Logical Reasoning (LR):** Analogy, blood relations, series, puzzles, direction sense, coding-decoding, Venn diagrams, logical connectives and data sufficiency.
