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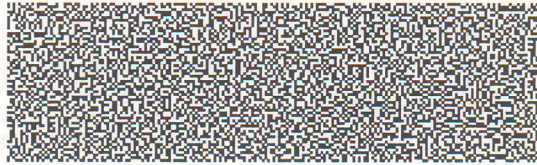
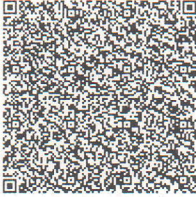

1. Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on Monday, the 27th October 2025 between **The Karnataka Law Society's Institute of Management Education and Research, Belagavi as first party** (hereafter referred as KLS IMER), an autonomous institute permanently affiliated to Rani Channamma University, Belagavi, known for its excellence in management education and community engagement, and **Dr. Sathe's Aarogya Mitra Foundation, Belagavi as Second party (hereafter referred as Aarogya Mitra Foundation)**, a team of dedicated healthcare professionals committed to building a preventive, accessible, and community-focused healthcare ecology.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative partnership between KLS IMER and Aarogya Mitra Foundation to design and implement institutional wellness initiatives, promote preventive healthcare awareness, and build a culture of holistic well-being among students, faculty, staff, and the larger community.

Both institutions share a common vision of contributing to societal wellness through education, outreach, and preventive healthcare practices.

3. Objectives of Collaboration

The collaboration aims to:

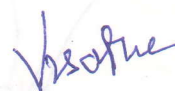
1. Conduct institutional wellness programs, health awareness sessions, and preventive healthcare camps/workshops.
2. Promote health literacy, stress management, and lifestyle improvement among students and faculty.
3. Facilitate health screening and counselling sessions within the IMER campus.
4. Engage students of KLS IMER in community wellness outreach initiatives in collaboration with Aarogya Mitra Foundation.
5. Explore research and training opportunities in healthcare management, mental well-being, and public health education.
6. Develop joint awareness campaigns, workshops, or events to enhance community engagement and social responsibility.

4. Roles and Responsibilities

Aarogya Mitra Foundation shall:

1. Provide professional expertise, medical guidance, and resource persons for wellness programs.
2. Conduct health screening, counselling, and awareness workshops on mutually agreed themes.
3. Facilitate linkages with healthcare professionals and allied institutions for specialized programs.


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KLS IMER shall:

1. Coordinate and host collaborative programs on campus or at mutually agreed venues.
2. Encourage participation of faculty, staff, and students in joint initiatives.
3. Promote and document the collaborative activities through its institutional channels.

5. Scope of Future Collaboration

Both the parties agree to explore additional avenues of cooperation, which may include:

1. Internship and project opportunities for MBA students in wellness, CSR, and healthcare-related areas.
2. Collaborative research and publication on wellness management, preventive healthcare, and employee well-being.
3. CSR partnerships for community-based health initiatives.
4. Development of educational modules or awareness materials integrating health and management perspectives.
5. Joint observance of international health days and outreach programs promoting community wellness.

6. Validity

This MoU shall remain valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of signing and may be extended or modified through mutual written consent of both parties.

7. Confidentiality and Intellectual Property

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding shared information and acknowledge that any intellectual property arising from jointly organized programs shall be jointly owned, subject to mutual agreement.

8. Financial Implications

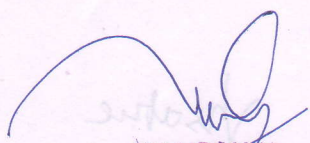
Any financial commitments or cost-sharing arrangements related to specific programs will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing before execution.

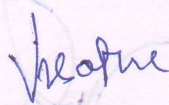
9. Review and Termination

10. General Provisions

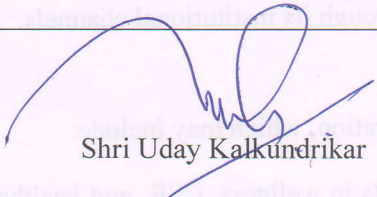
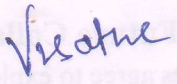
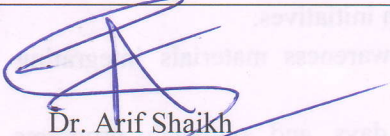
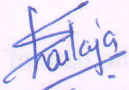
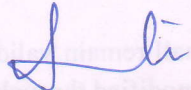
